



Teacher Instructions Christmas Cards

Please find enclosed drawing templates for the children to get started. Please keep drawings within the black border, anything outside the border will be cropped and will not appear on the design. If the design has any text make sure this is inside and **clear of the black border**. For best results we recommend that you use felt tip pens or coloured drawing pencils. You can also use paint or wax crayons.

Please do not use glitter, or stick anything down to the drawing template.

- Give out a drawing template to each child. (If you run out of templates you can photocopy or download extra from our website).
- Make sure drawings are within the black border on the drawing template. anything outside will be cropped. If the design is going to include writing make sure this is clear of the black border. Ensure the names are clearly readable at the bottom of the drawing template. (We advise that teachers write the child's name on the drawing template as this is printed on reverse of card please use BLOCK CAPITALS).
- For best results we recommended using Felt Tips, Coloured Pencils or Paint. Please do not use glitter or stick anything to the drawing templates.
- When drawings are complete collect in the drawing templates and place back in the envelope. Fill out label on the front of the envelope and keep safe ready for the organiser to collect.

Remember: If you run out of drawing templates you can download them from classfundraising.co.uk in the download section. Try and stick to the deadline given to you by the organiser. Please ensure all drawing templates have a child name and class name.
